In addition many who had completed courses relating to Buddhism received awards. Monks and nuns from Mahayana, Tibetan and Theravada temples witnessed the occasion. State government and Local Government too were represented at the function.

Temple, at 1 Paradise Road, Forestdale from 3.00 p.m. to 4.30 p.m.

Individuals who have completed courses in Buddhism, or have become Buddhist Chaplains can also be nominated.
