SHORT SAYINGS OF THE BUDDHA SELECTED FROM THE DHAMMAPADA

The scent of flowers cannot go against the wind; nor the scent of sandalwood, nor of tagara, nor of jasmine; only the reputation of virtuous ones (sappurisa) pervades in every direction.

There are the scents of sandalwood, tagara, lotus and jasmine; but the scent of virtue surpasses all scents.

(Dhammapada stanzas 54 and 55)

DEVELOPMENT OF MINDFULNESS PROGRAM SESSION 2 (SIB-008)

This program commenced in April and this is the second session. It will be held from 2.30 to 4.30 p.m. on Sunday 12 May 2019 in the meditation hall of the Sri Lanka Buddhist Monastery, 114 Considine Street, Ellen Grove, Queensland 4078.

For Session 2, a talk given in English by Venerable Dhammajeeva of the well-known forest monastery and meditation centre in Meethirigala, Sri Lanka will provide instructions for the sitting, walking and activity meditations. The talk will be mailed to invitees a few days before the program.

As the program session commences, a re-focusing meditation will take place through a pre-designed Dhamma conversation based on the talk. It will be conducted by Rahubadde Sarath-Chandra and a few others.

In session 1 there was an introduction to meditation, sitting meditation, walking meditation and a question and answer period. The first session was conducted by the Chief Monk, Sri Lanka Buddhist Monastery, Venerable Wattegama Dhammawasa Maha Thero.

BODHISATVA CARIYA EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

QSA is considering the possibility of conducting an educational program on the Bodhisatva Way in the hope of benefitting those who wish to have a happy and successful life rendering compassionate services to all and performing good deeds.

The contents are likely to include teachings found in both Mahayana and Theravada. At its present stage of development, the course will include three streams:

- A. The perfections developed by a Bodhisatva (in Theravada and Mahayana)
- B. Compassionate services to the community based on the fours divine abodes (Loving kindness, Compassion, Appreciative Joy and Equanimity) and the connection to the Bodhisatva Way.
- C. Self-Development for Happiness and Success in life in the modern world while observing Buddhist principles.
- D. The vast opportunities available for young people to apply Bodhisatva principles in a multitude of situations in this world of commerce and technology, using cultivated modern life-skills.

Readers are invited to make comments and suggestions for the development of this program tentatively numbered as SIB-009. A presentation in the near future is being planned.
