Workshop on Teaching Meditation and Chanting for Buddhist Chaplains

On Saturday 11th August fourteen people participated in this day long workshop which was held at the Inter-Faith Chaplaincy Unit at University of Queensland. Presentations and discussion occurred on a variety of topics

including: establishing and running a meditation group in a large Brisbane hospital; simple practices for beginner meditators; teaching meditation in large drop-in public spaces; working with prisoners; teaching meditation to children and teenagers; practice groups for people with addictions; walking meditation; trauma sensitive meditation; and chanting practices. The discussion was friendly, vibrant and informative! We will plan more workshops like this in the future.

DHAMMA RESEARCH PROGRAM (2)

The first Dhamma Research Program was held on I July 29018 and the topic was the Self-Concept or Sakkaya Ditthi. Dr. Sanka Wasalthilake conducted the program at the Sri Lanka Temple in Ellen Grove. It was based on Pali scriptures (Theravada). An analysis of the concept was presented and then followed by a question and discussion session. Some discourses were suggested for further reading.

The next program in the series will be announced next month.

One can ask why the research method is used here. If one looks at the seven factors of Awakening which is a part of the 37 factors of enlightenment, the second factor mentioned is Dhamma Vicaya. This means the critical examination of the Buddha's teaching. This in fact is similar to what is covered under the modern term Research.

THIRD QUENSLAND BUDDHIST CONVOCATION

The Queensland Buddhist Convocation has been held every year around this time since 2016. The convocation brought together members of the Buddhist Community regardless of traditions and origins. People who had rendered services to the Buddhist Community were recognized with the award of certificates. Those who were learning Buddhism through formal courses and those who had qualified as Buddhist Chaplains were also given certificates.

Volunteers working as Buddhism teachers in schools were also recognized by the award of certificates.
